




### Outside of term-time, where do you live in the UK? (UK students)




### What is your employment status during term time? (all)











## Student Welfare: Struggles

**Student Welfare - Struggles:** The top areas students struggle with remain consistent with Wave 1:

- Stress and anxiety (61%)
- Keeping up with the workload (45%)
- Work / life balance (42%)
- Feeling my uni experience has been impaired by the pandemic (39%)
- Having enough money to get by (37%)

While the majority (64%) get the help they need, 1/3 do not, with UGs more likely to disagree (41% vs 29% PGs). UGs are more likely to say they struggle with their academic life, such as understanding how to improve their academic performance (41%) and with study skills (39%), suggesting there could be a role for the SU in supporting students in these areas.



## Sport & Exercise

**Sports and Exercise:** Almost 1/2 participate in some form of sport while at university, with 3/10 playing sport informally with friends and family, and 1/10 as part of a sports club at Sheffield Hallam. The main reasons students take part is to improve their health and fitness (34%), to have fun (31%) and to make new friends (28%).

2/5 have an interest in increasing participation in sporting activities. However, the main barriers to getting involved are not knowing anyone else who takes part (34%), lack of skill (26%) and the perception it takes too much time (24%). This may indicate a need for more informal, 'just for fun' or beginners' opportunities to take part in sport.

The most commonly known sports facility is the University Gym (Pond Street and Collegiate Campus). However, 1/3 say they are not aware of any sports facilities at Sheffield Hallam, and fewer than 1 in 10 of those aware have used any sports facility.

Nonetheless, satisfaction with sports facilities is high among those who do use them, with the majority of users of each facility satisfied.






Which, if any, of the following sport and exercise facilities are you aware of at your university?
